	Definition	Examples	
<p>Campfire in a Fire Ring Not exceeding 6ft diameter</p>	<p>A small, open fire that is built directly upon the ground, typically used for warmth, cooking, or as a focal point for social gatherings.</p>		
<p>Chiminea</p>	<p>A freestanding fireplace or oven that has a wide-bottom vase form connected to a narrow smoke vent. Typically constructed of clay or terracotta but can also be made of copper, cast iron, steel, or cast aluminum.</p>		
<p>Manufactured Fire Pit</p>	<p>A movable vessel specifically manufactured for the purpose of containing an outdoor fire and preventing it from spreading.</p>		
<p>Outdoor grill/smoker Used for cooking only</p>	<p>Device used for cooking, typically fueled by charcoal, propane, or firewood.</p>		
<p>Patio Stove Used for cooking only</p>	<p>Open flame burner, typically fueled by propane or similar fuel, used for outdoor cooking.</p>		
<p>Outdoor Fireplace</p>	<p>An enclosed and permanently affixed outdoor fire receptacle which incorporates a permanently affixed chimney or flue, and is constructed of brick, rock or other masonry.</p>
