"I (We), the undersigned Applicant(s) for a pyrotechnics or flame effects permit, INTENDING TO BE LEGALLY BOUND HEREBY, state that neither I (we), nor anyone claiming by, through or under me (us), shall make any claim against the Township or against any public service agency, including but not limited to any fire company for any damage caused as a result of the pyrotechnics or flame effects, which is the subject of the application. Furthermore, I (we) agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Township, and all public service agencies, including but not limited to any fire company, and all officials, employees, and agents thereof, from any liability, claims, judgments, or damages alleged or claimed by any third party arising from the activities permitted hereby.

I (We) have read and understand the Warwick Township Fireworks and Pyrotechnics Ordinance, Chapter 170 of the Code of Ordinances, and agree to comply with all its terms and provisions, subject to the penalties set forth therein.

Further, I (we) hereby agree that the permit obtained by this application is non-transferrable and that in the event of a change to any of the information provided on this Application and Required Standards Forms, I (we) agree to notify the Township within forty-eight (48) hours of such changes.

I/We understand that I/we have an obligation to provide the Township of Warwick and the WESC Fire Commissioner with updated information immediately, should any information change from the stated above.

I/We understand that the WESC Fire Commissioner or designee may suspend the permit obtained by this application if, in his sole discretion, the permitted pyrotechnics or flame effects activities will constitute a public safety hazard. I/We understand and agree that if the WESC Fire Commissioner, in his sole discretion, decides to dispatch fire company members and/or equipment to the scene, I/We will be subject to an additional fee.
