




Projects within the Lititz Run Watershed

Millport Conservancy - Phase I completion the bog turtle habitat is lower-left photo




The Riparian Park project, located below the Lititz Wastewater Treatment plant, included a wetland area and tree planting.










In 1997, improvements along the Lititz Run included Lititz Borough







