	Definition	Examples	
Campfire in a Fire Ring Not exceeding 6ft diameter	A small, open fire that is built directly upon the ground, typically used for warmth, cooking, or as a focal point for social gatherings.		
Chiminea	A freestanding fireplace or oven that has a wide- bottom vase form connected to a narrow smoke vent. Typically constructed of clay or terracotta but can also be made of copper, cast iron, steel, or cast aluminum.		
Manufactured Fire Pit	A movable vessel specifically manufactured for the purpose of containing an outdoor fire and preventing it from spreading.		
Outdoor grill/smoker Used for cooking only	Device used for cooking, typically fueled by charcoal, propane, or firewood.		
Patio Stove Used for cooking only	Open flame burner, typically fueled by propane or similar fuel, used for outdoor cooking.		
Outdoor Fireplace	An enclosed and permanently affixed outdoor fire receptacle which incorporates a permanently affixed chimney or flue, and is constructed of brick, rock or other masonry.
