	Definition	Examples	
<b>Campfire in a Fire Ring</b> Not exceeding 6ft diameter	A small, open fire that is built directly upon the ground, typically used for warmth, cooking, or as a focal point for social gatherings.		
<b>Chiminea</b>	A freestanding fireplace or oven that has a wide-bottom vase form connected to a narrow smoke vent. Typically constructed of clay or terracotta but can also be made of copper, cast iron, steel, or cast aluminum.		
<b>Manufactured Fire Pit</b>	A movable vessel specifically manufactured for the purpose of containing an outdoor fire and preventing it from spreading.		
<b>Outdoor grill/smoker</b> Used for cooking only	Device used for cooking, typically fueled by charcoal, propane, or firewood.		
<b>Patio Stove</b> Used for cooking only	Open flame burner, typically fueled by propane or similar fuel, used for outdoor cooking.		
<b>Outdoor Fireplace</b>	An enclosed and permanently affixed outdoor fire receptacle which incorporates a permanently affixed chimney or flue, and is constructed of brick, rock or other masonry.
