## **Curb Stops**

WTMA would like to advise all customers with a water connection that it is very important to not only know where your curb stop is located, but also to have your curb stop accessible to our staff should there be a need to turn off the water service to your property.

From the surface, your curb stop looks like a round metal plate, approximately three inches in diameter with the word "WATER" stamped on the top. Below the surface, there is a box that contains a valve which controls the flow of water to your property. This valve is accessed with a special wrench which turns the valve on or off.


Generally curb stops are located near the sidewalk (or street if you don't have a sidewalk) at the front edge of your property. Please ensure that your curb stop is free from obstructions such as mulch or blacktop. WTMA staff can assist you in finding your curb stop if you are unable to do so.



#### **Hydrant Access**

A reminder to residents with fire hydrants that unobstructed access to fire hydrants should be maintained at all times. Landscaping, or other obstructions should not be placed within four feet of a fire hydrant. It is imperative that emergency personnel be able to quickly locate a fire hydrant in the event of an emergency.


